



Employee Payroll Deduction Agreement

Employees may elect to have memberships dues for themselves and their family deducted from payroll as long as at least one (1) adult employee ages 18+ participates in the payroll deduction program with the employer.

The employer is required to enroll as an employer group with Mint Health Clinics Lone Tree. Membership can start on any day of the month, and membership fees will be prorated for the start month.

Automatic bank draft, credit, or debit card can be used for payment. Invoices will be sent on the 1st of every month, with payments due on the 10th of every month.
